FOR CURRENT 4s

We're enriching our summer program for BEPS' oldest children with week-long investigations focusing on topics such as The Children's Garden Project, The Famous Artist Series, Animals in our World, and Sports, Sports, Sports. Children will explore these topics through art, science, math, games, cooking, movement and more.

Some important information about Beth El Summer Time

- BEST will run Tuesdays through Fridays for two three-week sessions. Session 1 is June 22-July 9. Session 2 is July 13-July 30.
